Cecil County Public Library to reopen renovated Perryville Branch

Perryville, MD – Cecil County Public Library will complete a facility update of the Perryville Branch Library and reopen to the public on Saturday, July 27, 2024 with a brief ribbon cutting at 10am.

The goals of this project were to maximize the Library's layout for better zoning of age groups and activities; specifically in the after-school hours when serving students from area schools. The branch will add an enclosed Teen Room, 2 study rooms, for a total of 4, and will repurpose a computer lab into a Job & Technology center to support the needs of the community, especially the many veterans from the Perry Point VA Hospital who visit the Library for workforce development services and technology classes.

"Perryville is one of the most heavily used branches in the system," stated Rachel Wright, Interim Director of CCPL. "After 16 years of serving the community, the renovated Library will improve the experience for all users."

The Library appreciates the community partners who worked with us to continue to provide

Library programs and services during this project, including the Town of Perryville, Perryville Middle School and Perryville Police Outreach.
