## Introduction to Zoom

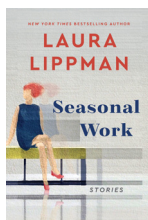
**Tuesday, September 12 at 10:30am**

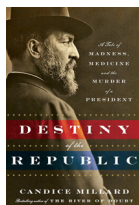
