Protects the inventor by conferring the right to "exclude others from making, using, offering for sale, or selling" the registered invention within the US.

LEGAL STRUCTURE

Before you register your business, you must determine your: **LEGAL OWNERSHIP STRUCTURE.**



SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP

One owner. Personal liability for debts. Not taxed as an entity.



PARTNERSHIP

Two or more partners. Personal liability for debts. Not taxed as an entity.



LIMITED LIABILITY CO. (LLC)

One or more members. Limited liability for debts. (Business separate from Personal) Must file with MD Dept. of Taxation.



CORPORATION

One or more shareholders. Limited liability for debts. Managed by directors elected by shareholders. Must file with MD Dept. of Taxation.
