#### Q What are my options FOR FUNDING? A

→ **GRANTS:** A government grant is a financial award given by the federal, state, or local government for a beneficial project. The grantee is not expected to repay the money.

→ **BOOTSTRAPPING:** Use savings, credit cards, home equity loan, or borrowed money from friends & family.

→ **BANKS:** Local banks can work with you to secure a commercial loan.

→ **SBA:** The Small Business Administration does not give out loans; rather, they provide loan guarantees to banks to encourage the funding of small businesses.

**Patent**

Protects the inventor by conferring the right to "exclude others from making, using, offering for sale, or selling" the registered invention within the US.

**Trademark**

Any word, name, symbol, device, or combination thereof used to identify and distinguish the goods of one manufacturer to another.

Protects original works of authorship fixed in a tangible medium of expression, such as writing, music, photos, and more.

### select LEGAL STRUCTURE

Before you register your business, you must determine your: **LEGAL OWNERSHIP STRUCTURE.**



#### SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP

One owner.  
Personal liability for debts.  
Not taxed as an entity.



#### PARTNERSHIP

Two or more partners.  
Personal liability for debts.  
Not taxed as an entity.



#### LIMITED LIABILITY CO. (LLC)

One or more members.  
Limited liability for debts.  
(Business separate from Personal)  
Must file with MD Dept. of Taxation.



#### CORPORATION

One or more shareholders.  
Limited liability for debts.  
Managed by directors elected by shareholders.  
Must file with MD Dept. of Taxation.

**ALSO KNOWN AS:** Federal Tax ID Number or Tax Identification Number (TIN)

**USES:** Business bank accounts, hiring employees, tax reporting
